At more than **30 locations** across the country, Hope Lodge communities serve more than **29,000 patients and caregivers** each year.



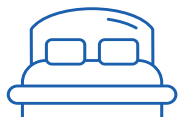
The first Hope Lodge location opened its doors in **1970** in Charleston, South Carolina.



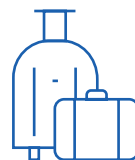
Hope Lodge guests have come from all **50 states** and more than **45 countries**.
